The Immigrant Legal Clinic of the Tennessee Coalition to End Domestic & Sexual Violence provides free consultations and legal representation to immigrant victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or trafficking.

Since the Immigrant Legal Clinic opened in 2005, it has helped over 2000 victims of domestic and sexual violence understand their immigration options or apply for immigration benefits.



WE CAN HELP

- Provide free consultations in-person or by phone
- Determine possible immigration options
- Assist in filing immigration applications, including:
 - *U-Visas (victims of crime)*
 - *T-Visas (victims of trafficking)*
 - *Asylum*
 - *Special Immigrant Juvenile Status*
 - *VAWA self-petitions*
 - *Employment Authorization (work permit)*
- Provide advocacy services to help connect you to resources in your area
